Jumping into a multi-arts festival experience bringing the weird, wonderful and unexpected to reality for 107 on The Rocks – we are taking over four unique historically significant spaces, all with their own magic: Atherden St.; The Gallery; Coroner's Court & The Courtyard.

Our Courtyard Pop-Up Bar will feature drinks from local bars Hickson House and The Keel, plus burgers, nibbles, a pop-up Oyster Bar and a special BBQ popping up throughout the festival. This will feature alongside a diverse line-up of live music from a mix of genres including R&B, funk, hip-hop, jazz all mixed together as they put live music back on stage.

"Spirits on The Rocks" are a series of Aboriginal Female protector spirits created by artistic duo Madwings (Maddison Gibbs and Jason Wing). The images are drawn in nature sitting, listening, watching, slowing down and letting nature guide the story. There are 6 different spirits and the imagery is drawn from seeds, nuts, plants, medicine. The spirits lay the path around 'Tallowoladah', they reflect women leading the way for regeneration of country and culture as they have done so for thousands of years.

Join us for everything from all inclusive workshop sessions during the school holidays to late night live music.

Many exhibitions and events are free, but we recommend registering online to secure your preferred time. So join us this April to rediscover this iconic harbour-side suburb.

These spirits will pave the way... connecting the three Rocks pop-up venues and enticing people to explore.

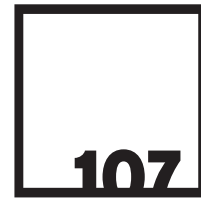

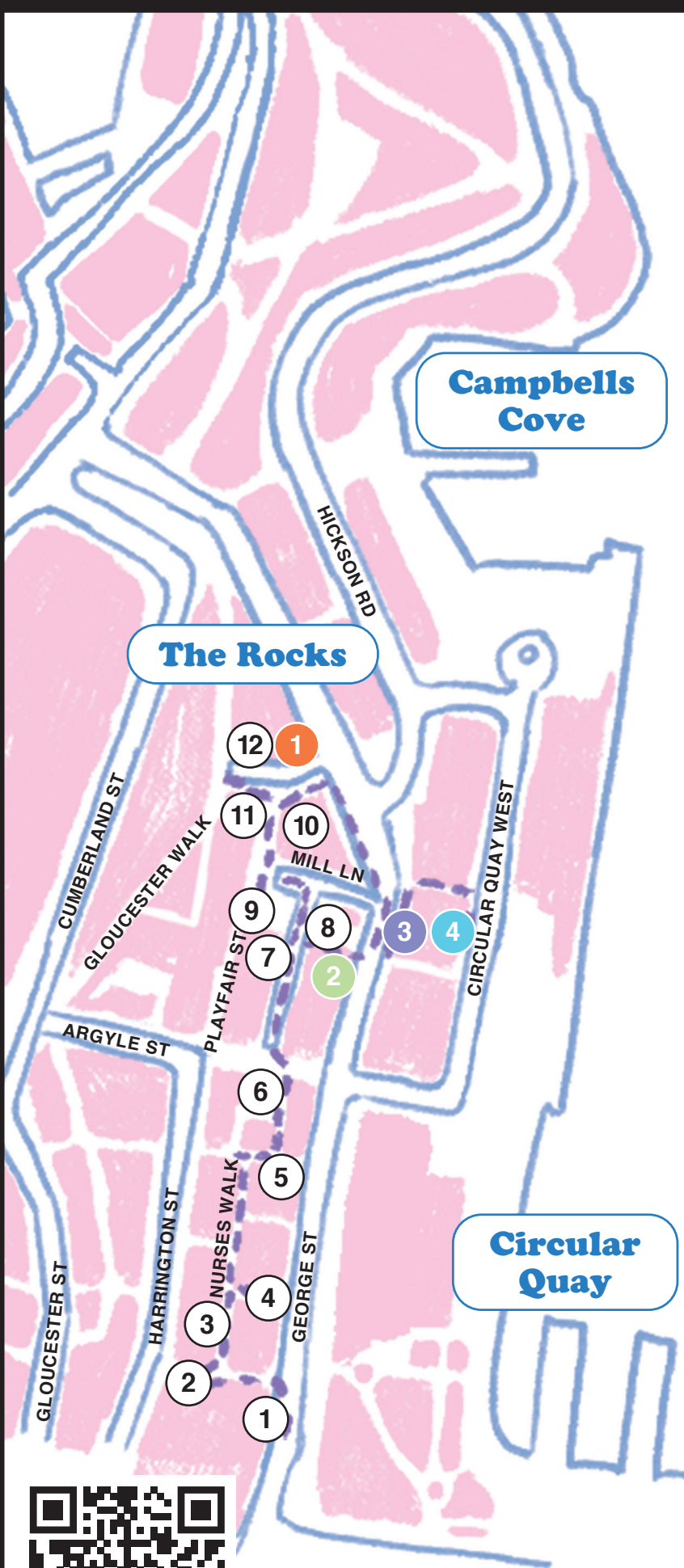

100 Capes by The House That Dan Built

While confined to their houses during the 2020 lockdown, The House found 100 women from remote, regional, metropolitan and urban communities in every Australian state to participate in making 100 Capes that will eventually be worn by 100 girls when mass singing is one day allowed again. 100 Capes is a visual and auditory exploration of the experiences women across Australia share. 100 women's voices are represented in the interviews and bring to life the extraordinary stories that can be found in the everyday. Audiences navigate their stories, held within red capes and interspersed with music composed by emerging artists.

'Duruga Dyurir' Falling Star Dust by Nadeena Dixon

Duruga Dyurir translates in the Gadigal Language of the Sydney basin as 'Falling Stardust'. Through the work Dixon creates alignments to Gadigal Dharawal, Bidjigal Sydney Saltwater peoples Cosmologies related to star dust as a metaphor for matter in minute particles that exist in everything. In Creation stories that have been handed down through bloodlines for thousands of years, Gadigal, Dharawal Bidjigal Peoples still maintain strong cultural practices given them by the Creator that are still being maintained today.

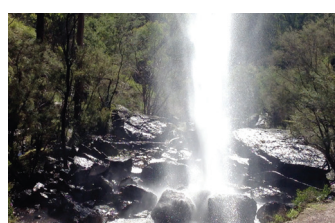
devil devil by Nicole Monks & Jenine Boeree

Take a walk with Uncle Billy through the stories hidden in the basement of the Coroner's Court in The Rocks and you be the judge.

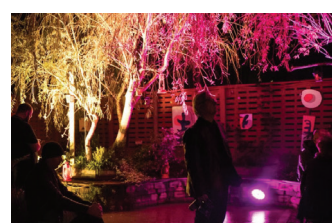


Rise & Falls by Blak Douglas

The object of this piece is to 'reclaim' the urban facade in an attempt to restore the landscape to pre Colonisation. Imagining the cascading freshwater making its way down from the site of the Sydney Observatory. Prior to the rapid development of the docklands & its surrounds, the beauty of this tract of Cadigal Country would have been astounding.

Born Adam Douglas Hill, 1970 in Blacktown, Western Sydney to a Dhungatti Aboriginal Father / Caucasian Mother. Trained in illustration & photography, became self - practiced in painting. A classically trained Yidaki player performing nationally and internationally accompanying the likes of Christine Anu, Jessica Mauboy, and Peter Sculthorpe.

Studio Dennis 3D will bloom to fill the Coroners Court courtyard with a garden of delight. Layers of modular pieces create a dense colourful arrangement of shapes transforming an empty urban space into bright, bold celebration. This work forms around for the 107 Balmy Nights programming but in daytime it is a stand-alone installation that offers respite from the hustle and bustle of the CBD.

Andrew B-W is an artist living and working in the sub tropics of Sydney since 2000. Studio Dennis is the collective name for a practice which covers multiple outputs such as mural art, painting, design, textiles and street graphics. Drawing from a diverse range of influences including 20th century art, low-brow comics, skateboard culture and points in-between, Studio Dennis has developed a unique language that is complex and unique.
